

Northwoods at Coulwood Swim Club Rules: 2025

The Northwoods Swim Club is a Swim at Your Own Risk Facility. Parents or legal guardians are responsible for children 14 years of age or under. Children in floaties or wings must be in arms reach of their parent or the responsible adult.

- The Swim Club is for residents and their guests. Pool members are responsible for their guests' actions and must accompany their guests during the entire visit. Please make sure your guests understand and abide by the pool rules.
- All people visiting the clubhouse and pool must abide by pool rules and instructions by the Pool Attendants.
- Northwoods @ Coulwood HOA is not responsible for loss, damage or theft of members personal belongings or property. Pool toys, goggles, snorkels and similar are the responsibility of the owners and may not be left at the pool.
- No pets are allowed in the clubhouse or pool areas.
- **No balls are allowed except inflatable beach balls.**
- Rafts, pool noodles or other flotation devices may be used in the pool at the Pool Attendants' or Boards discretion.
- The Swim Club is a smoke-free area, this includes smokeless or vaping products.
- Please eat in the designated areas only. Picnic tables are the designated areas and are for short term use for eating. These picnic tables are not for storing gear or pool supplies.
- No food or beverages are allowed within 10 feet of the pool. Alcoholic beverages must be in discrete containers and must be kept at your seat.
- Any person suspected of intoxication of any sort will be asked to leave the pool. Pool personnel have been instructed to contact law enforcement if a member or their guest does not leave the clubhouse grounds.
- The Health Department requires ALL swimmers to shower prior to entering the pool or after using tanning solutions. Showers are available in the bathroom facilities and on the main deck beside the kiddie pool.
- No street clothing is allowed in the pool – swim apparel only. **Clothing must not contain any cotton or be a cotton blend** because loose fibers can affect the pool filter's ability to function properly. Polyester swim shirts are ok.
- No horse play including but not limited to running, dunking, pushing, wrestling, splashing, throwing people in the pool, sitting or standing on shoulders is allowed.
- **No diving allowed.**
- **Profane or abusive language is not allowed.**
- No climbing on or over fences, gates or furniture.
- Furniture is not allowed in the kiddie pool No loitering at the clubhouse entry or pool deck.
- The Pool Attendants cannot be distracted from their responsibilities so please keep conversations to a minimum.
- The Pool Attendants or a Board member can close the pool if weather issues become a concern. The pool and pool deck must be evacuated.
- Due to close proximity to resident homes, no music will be allowed unless it's provided by the HOA. Members may listen to music using headphones on their personal electronic devices.

- Only authorized personnel are allowed in the pool pump room, clubhouse or pool storage areas.
- Pool tags will not be issued until the pool tag application form and payment have been received and processed by William Douglas Management. **Members must have their pool tags to be admitted to the pool.** Tags must be presented to the Pool Attendants before entering the pool area. **No tags, no entry**
- **The Attendants have permission to inspect any or all bags, coolers, etc. Glass is not allowed inside the pool gate. There are no exceptions to this policy. If there is an incident involving glass, a fine of \$5,000.00 will be applied to the resident's account.**
- Misuse of tags can result in confiscation of the tags. Refunds will not be issued.
- Tags will be issued to members 15 years old or older. Members aged 14 or under must be accompanied by a parent or adult who is 18 or older.
- Guests (limit of 4 per household) will get a wristband that must be worn during their visit. This band is for one time use only. A new wristband will be issued for each visit.
- If a pool tag is lost, a new one will be replaced at a cost of \$10.00.
- Bicycles, skateboards, scooters, rollerblades or similar are NOT permitted inside the pool area.
